2011 - 2012 Term Registration Information

The following contains information about registration with the Dartmouth Whalers Masters Swim Club. Please read carefully.

TERM SCHEDULE AND SWIM TIMES

The swimming year is divided into two terms:

Term 1: September 11th, 2011 - January 26th, 2012

Term 2: January 29th, 2012 - June 14th, 2012

The team practices on Sundays 8:15 – 9:30 p.m, Tuesdays 8:15¹ – 9:15, and Thursdays, 8:30 – 9:30 p.m.

Membership to the Dartmouth Whalers is completely separate from a Dartmouth Sportsplex membership. Being a Whalers member does not entitle you to the use of other Sportsplex facilities such as the weight room, pirates cove, etc. or use of the pool outside of Dartmouth Whalers Masters Swim club practice times.

The front desk will let you in approximately 15 - 20 min. before the scheduled swim time.

FEES

All fees must be paid at the start of the year by one of two methods:

In full :

\$300.00 + \$25 to Swim Nova Scotia Fee. Total: \$325

-or-

2 post dated cheques:

Sunday September 11/2011 \$150.00

Sunday January 29/2012 \$150.00

\$25 Swim Nova Scotia Fee (Paid at time of registration)

The annual registration fee of \$25 to Swim Nova Scotia registers you as member, which provides you with coverage for accident and liability insurance. All members must be registered with Swim Nova Scotia; the Club will forward your information and fee.

Fees must be paid by one of these methods before you will be considered registered and be eligible to swim. Please make cheques payable to Dartmouth Whalers Masters Swim Club.

¹Due to uncertainty in the winter program scheduling the Tuesday swim may revert to 8:30-9:30pm

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Note that payment by either method in no way commits you to swimming the second term. Anyone wishing to discontinue their membership prior to the start of the second term has only to notify the President (Wendy Shulman), Treasurer (Mike Sears), or Registrar (Marti Maguire) and the remaining post-dated cheque will be destroyed or fees for the second term refunded, as appropriate.

Post-dated cheques will be cashed on or shortly after the start of the second term. Reminder announcements will be made by e-mail and on the pool deck.

If space is available, new members can join the club at anytime during the year. After the first four weeks of the term, fees will be pro-rated based on the number of weeks left in the current term.

Payment must be received by Friday, September 9th, so allow sufficient time for the mail. No member's registration is considered complete until payment is received.

Registration is first come - first served. There will be registration sessions before practice during the first week of the first term. These will be located at the Dartmouth Sportsplex, at 7:30 - 8:00 p.m. Sunday, September, 11th and 7:30 to 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday September 13th and 15th. Please be prepared to pay your fees at registration.

SHARED MEMBERSHIP

We recognize that members have busy lives and often can't commit to swimming every practice; so we are pleased to offer the ability for two members of the same household to split one membership. Under this option, only one swimmer may participate per practice. Please note, each swimmer must pay the \$25.00 Swim Nova Scotia fee. Both members will have to register separately and indicate whom they are sharing their membership with (by name).

WAITING LIST

If the club membership limit (currently set at 65) is reached, a waiting list will be started. People will be called up from the waiting list to fill second term vacancies caused by departing members.

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TRIAL PRACTICE

A one-practice trial is available for potential new members who want to see what a practice is like before committing to join the club. To take advantage, new swimmers should contact our registrar.

REFUND POLICY

There are no pro-rated refunds once the term has started. It is the responsibility of an individual swimmer to notify the registrar before the start of the second term if they do not intend to continue swimming. Once the second term has started and the cheques are cashed, there are no refunds.
